Marina Heinonen is Professor in Food Chemistry at the University of Helsinki. Previously she has held a position as a Professor in Functional Foods for a 5-year term (August 2002- July 2007). She earned the doctoral degree in Food Science (Food Chemistry) at the University of Helsinki in 1990. Her research interests include protein and lipid oxidation, antioxidant action, and functional properties of plant phenolics. She has published more than 90 original articles and a number of other publications. Since 2007 she has been a member of the Research Council for Biosciences and Environment at the Academy of Finland. Her present international activities include expert membership in working groups on Health Claims and Novel Foods of the Scientific Panel on Dietetic Products, Nutrition and Allergies (NDA) at the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA) after previous memberships since 2004 both in the NDA Panel and the Scientific Panel on Food
